At Eastpointe High School, our focus is to ENGAGE our students both academically and socially. PREPARE each student to have the fundamentals needed to succeed today and onward into their futures. SUCCEED, it is our vision to instill the fundamentals for life while assisting you to stay on track for graduation. This is what our Secondary Credit Recovery Summer School Program can do for you.

The new high school state requirements have increased rigor and relevance to student learning. Due to these new requirements, students do not have a lot of room for error in earning credits in order to stay on track to graduate with their scheduled class of peers. Every credit is of great importance. The Secondary Credit Recovery Summer School Program is designed to provide opportunities for students to earn credits they had previously failed. It is an additional support to our students' academic success and positive opportunity to recover their required courses.

All Eastpointe High School Secondary Credit Recovery Summer School Course will be conducted virtually using the Edmentum PLATO System. The online PLATO program will provide each student with their own personalized lesson plans and course offerings designed to promote self-paced learning, academic progression and credit recovery achievement. This is accomplished by students being allowed to progress through their studies at their own pace while showing mastery of the concepts by passing the section assessments allowing for their progression throughout the coursework. All students will be mentored by a certified teacher available to assist all students with motivation, clarification of subject matter, answer questions and guide students in taking the knowledge and skills presented and putting them into practice.

## In Person attendance is available daily Monday through Thursday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

ALL students are required to complete all coursework in each course before they may enroll in a second course. Note: Courses are NOT approved by NCAA for eligibility purposes.

Once a teacher has reviewed the course and confirmed the student has completed a course, they may either register for an additional course, or be finished with the program. All courses are worth one half credit (0.5) If a student needs to make up a full credit course, he/she should sign up for the two courses of the class( A-S1 & B-S2).

- You should take guided notes (available as a function of the program) from lectures and tutorials. Teachers may request evidence to have any tests or assignments unlocked.
- You may not leave your station at any time during a lecture; you must listen to the entire lecture/tutorial for each lesson and fill-in/complete the guided notes.
- ALL of the following components MUST be successfully completed by earning a minimum of 60% or better and will be considered to determine your final grade.
- Mastery Tests, Quizzes, Post-Tests, and Final Course Tests.

**GRADES:** At the conclusion of the EHS Secondary Credit Recovery Summer School Program, notification of grades will be sent to each student's home school/counselor. It is the student's responsibility to make sure that grades become part of their official transcripts.
